MEREWETHER GOLF CLUB MIXED FOURSOMES' CHAMPIONSHIP

Conditions of play

Open to all male and female members with a playing category membership, with a current GA handicap at Merewether Golf Club.

All 6-day member players will be charged the same entry fee as 7-day members. Other playing categories will pay their usual category fee for a Saturday.

A team will consist of 1 male and 1 female player.

For the Championships, play is from the **red tees** for women and blue tees for men, as set out on the day.

This is an 18-hole stroke competition, played over 18 holes on the same day.

In **Foursomes (see Rule 22)** golfers compete in teams of two, using only one ball per team, and taking alternate shots until the hole is completed.

Even numbered years, the male player tees off all even tees, the female player tees off all odd tees.

Odd numbered years, the male player tees off all odd tees, the female player tees off all even tees.

The championship winners are the team with the lowest gross score over the field.

There will be prizes awarded for best scratch score and runner up. If, after 18 holes of play, there is a tie in this event the Golf Aust. method of countback shall be employed.

There will be a prize for the lowest nett score and runner up (in the event of a tie for second the Golf Aust method of countback will be used).

Any other prizes will be at the discretion of the Club Operations Committee.

Players are eligible to win one prize. Balls are awarded on the nett results, after the best nett and runner up. (scratch winner and runner up will also be excluded).

The Alternative Competition of the day is an individual mixed stableford. All players use their handicap of the day as displayed on the GNSW handicap site. If there is a tie in this event the Golf Aust. method of countback shall be employed.

These Conditions of Play are to be read and interpreted in conjunction with the Rules of Golf, the local rules and general conditions of play of Merewether Golf Club.

The Club Operations Committee reserves the right to alter or make any variations to the conditions of play, the fixtures book, the number of divisions, or to the award of any trophy.

PLEASE be aware of your pace of play and keep up with the group in front.
