Membership Subscription and Dishonoured Payment Procedure

Merewether Golf Club offers monthly payment arrangements as a convenient way for members to pay their annual membership subscription by instalments. Monthly instalments do not constitute a month-to-month membership, and members remain liable for the full annual subscription.

Annual Membership Renewal Notices

The Club will issue the following notices to members:

- An annual membership subscription notice approximately 30 days before the member's renewal date.
- A reminder notice on the date the membership subscription becomes due.
- A default notice seven days after the renewal date where the subscription remains unpaid.

Members will be provided with a seven-day grace period following their renewal date to finalise payment.

Where the membership subscription has not been paid within seven days of the renewal date:

- The member will be deemed unfinancial.
- Membership privileges will be suspended.
- Access will be removed from the Club's membership and golfing systems.
- The member will not be able to access member playing rights, competition entry, online member bookings, member discounts, honour board events, monthly medals or other membership benefits.

Monthly Instalment Payments

Members paying by monthly instalments must ensure sufficient funds are available on the scheduled payment date.

Where a monthly payment is dishonoured:

- The Club will notify the member that the payment has failed.
- The payment will be re-attempted within five to seven days.
- Any dishonour or administration fees charged to the Club will be passed on to the member.

Where the re-attempted payment is also dishonoured, or the outstanding amount is not paid by the required date:

- The member will be deemed unfinancial.
- Membership privileges will be suspended.
- Access will be removed from the Club's membership and golfing systems.
- The member will not be able to access member playing rights, competition entry, online member bookings, member discounts, honour board events, monthly medals or other membership benefits.

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Reinstatement of Membership Privileges

Membership privileges will only be reinstated once:

- All overdue subscription amounts have been paid.
- Any dishonour or administration fees have been paid.
- Any other outstanding amounts owing to the Club have been paid.

Repeated Dishonoured Payments

Where a member has:

- Two dishonoured payments within a six-month period; or
- Three dishonoured payments within a membership year,

the Club may cancel the member's monthly payment arrangement.

Where the monthly payment arrangement is cancelled:

- The remaining balance of the annual membership subscription will become payable in full.
- The member may be required to pay future membership fees annually in advance.
- Any future monthly payment arrangement will be at the discretion of the General Manager.

Where a member remains unfinancial for more than 30 days after their membership privileges have been suspended, the Club may cancel or resign the membership in accordance with the Club's By-Laws and membership terms.

The General Manager may consider genuine financial hardship or exceptional circumstances on a case-by-case basis. Any alternative payment arrangement approved by the General Manager must be confirmed in writing.
